## **DRIVING DIRECTIONS**


From Lake Cities Church of Christ

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Who can attend camp? Children entering 3rd to 5th grades.

When do I register? Early bird registration begins February 1, 2015. Registration forms may be found online at lakecitieschurch.com on the Children's Ministry page.
